

Technical Rider & AV Requirements

Speaker: Nabil Pervez

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To ensure the best possible presentation experience for your audience, please review the following technical requirements.

1. Computer & Display

- **Laptop:** Nabil prefers to present from his own laptop (MacBook Pro) to ensure custom fonts, high-resolution creative assets, and embedded videos play correctly.
- **Connectivity:** Please provide an **HDMI connection** at the podium or tech table. Nabil travels with a USB-C to HDMI adapter but appreciates a backup cable.
- **Aspect Ratio:** Slides are formatted in **16:9 Widescreen**.
- **Clicker:** Nabil travels with his own remote clicker but can use a provided cue system if necessary.

2. Audio

- **Microphone:** Wireless **Lavalier (Lapel)** or **Headset** microphone is required. Nabil uses his hands while speaking and requires mobility. Handheld microphones are not preferred unless on a panel.
- **Computer Audio:** The presentation includes video and audio elements. Please ensure the HDMI connection (or a separate 3.5mm jack) runs into the house sound system. **Sound checks are mandatory.**

3. Staging & Lighting

- **Movement:** Nabil utilizes the stage. Please ensure the stage area is clear of cables and obstructions.
- **Lectern:** A lectern/podium is fine for holding water and the laptop, but Nabil will not stand behind it for the duration of the talk.
- **Lighting:** Standard stage wash. If the session is being recorded, please ensure three-point lighting to avoid shadows.
- **Confidence Monitor:** A downstage confidence monitor (showing current slide + timer) is highly preferred but not mandatory.

4. Internet

- **Connection:** While the presentation is locally hosted, a hardline (Ethernet) connection or dedicated speaker Wi-Fi is requested for live demos or website showcases if the topic requires it.

5. Recording & Distribution

- **Permission:** You are authorized to record the session for internal archives or attendee distribution.
- **Social Media:** Live tweeting and photography by the audience are encouraged.
